



## Regional Waste Job Opportunities

We are looking for reliable and dependable staff to provide regional waste services to the residents of Clearwater County. All applicants must be physically fit, courteous and helpful to the public, and be available to work weekends and provide cover-off to other staff. Successful candidates must provide their own transportation to work sites. Work sites will require the successful persons to be exposed to an outdoor environment, which involves dirt, odors, noise, weather extremes or similar elements most of the workday.

### Transfer Station Attendants [Part-time]

Assignable Locations: Caroline, Crammond, Everdell, Crossroads, Cow Lake, Faraway, Nordegg and Rocky Mountain House.

#### Duties:

- Greet, assist and direct customers with appropriate sorting of materials, disposal of special waste materials, answering customer inquiries, directing and controlling traffic flow.
- Communicate with customers and drivers verbally or by hand signals.
- Operate the transfer site to meet municipal public service standards and regulatory requirements.
- Maintain cleanliness and appearance of site by walking the site, manually pick up debris.
- Uses hand tools such as shovels, picks, axes and chain saws.
- Participates with other Waste and Recycling staff in the County's Health and Safety program including: training, preventative maintenance, facility inspections, hazard assessment and reporting, and ensure safe work practices are followed.

Assignable Hours: Weekdays: 10:00am to 6:00pm; Weekends: 2:30pm to 6:00pm

Wage Rate: \$21.20/hr

#### Requirements:

- Ability to read, write, identify hazard symbols.
- Communicate verbally, with hand gestures, complete written reports or information.
- Class 5 license/provide Drivers' Abstract.

## Collections Hauler/Driver

### Duties:

- Operate heavy-duty trucks with front load as well as tractor trailer units and skid steers
- Load and haul refuse/recyclables to regional landfill
- Navigates roadways, driveways, alleyways, and lots requiring backing-up maneuvers.
- Operates vehicle in accordance with Occupational Health and Safety and Provincial transportation regulations.
- Performs pre-trip inspections and immediately reports unsafe situations or service issues
- Notifies office of service interruptions, including blocked containers, closed lots, streets, alleyways or potential safety hazards.
- Identifies and reports all containers in need of repair or replacement.
- Completely dumps all containers and leaves the customer's location clean and free of debris. Positions and returns containers on the customer's property in a manner that ensures lids are closed and secured, and containers do not block driveway entrances or traffic.
- Participates with other Waste and Recycling staff in the County's Health and Safety program including: training, preventative maintenance, facility inspections, hazard assessment and reporting, and ensure safe work practices are followed.

Hours: 40 hours/week

Wage rate: Class 3 Driver [minimum qualification] \$28.37/hr  
Class 1 Driver [preferred] \$30.08/hr

### Requirements:

- Minimum 3 years work experience operating a vehicle requiring a Class 3 or higher license.
- Hold a current Class 3 with air brake endorsement [Note: Class 1 is preferred].
- Meet physical job requirements including ability to perform pushing, pulling, bending, twisting and lifting up to 50 lbs.
